

Brewer Band Boosters Meeting Minutes

Minutes from the previous band boosters meeting, 9/14/23, were reviewed. August meeting minutes were motioned to be accepted by Kelli McDowell and seconded by Renee Bennett.

Treasurer's report for September was reviewed by Brent Herring. Expenses and income were shared for the month—starting balance was \$11,191.21 and the ending balance was \$34,482.69. Mr. Williams' fund has \$33,127.61. Miscellaneous fund has \$4,799.01 and Booster funds has \$16,124.00.

Old Business

Swag Bag update: problem with the baseball caps. This is the reason it's taking longer to get the Swag Bags. The vendor will be shipping them soon.

Corinna discussed the updated Bylaws so we could vote on them. It was approved and will be uploaded to the website.

We sold out of pizza, coke, hot dogs by halftime of the last game. We are selling \$6 Chick-fil-a sandwiches and \$7 Chicken Express Snack Boxes. We will have Coke and Sweet Tea.

Kelli asked if it was better getting ice the day of or the day before.

Mr. Williams is going to ask Jessie about purchasing a new ice machine.

Kelli discussed Painting with a Twist. The district approved the event. It will probably happen in Spring of 2024. We need at least 10 to make a profit. Meet the Bears Rally was a hot evening. This probably affected the t-shirt sales. We are going to try selling them online. They are going to be kept at the Concession Stand to make it easier for logistics.
